I am writing in response to your question regarding the acceptance of the Verification and Enrollment Form from individuals participating in a home school program.

The Department considers the Verification and Enrollment Form a school record. Therefore, it is acceptable as a supporting document under our identification policy. Pursuant to our policy, each new applicant must supply one primary document, two secondary documents or a secondary document along with two supporting documents. As stated in your letter, an original or certified copy of your birth certificate, a social security card issued by the Social Security Administration, and the Verification and Enrollment Form meet the requirements of the Department's identification policy.

The Department will also accept the Verification and Enrollment Form as proof of school enrollment from students participating in a home school program.
