In response to your letter addressed to Sharla Adam and dated February 3, 2017, Angelo State University has made the following modifications to the Home School Admission process.

1. Home School students applying for admission are no longer required to submit the Texas Private High School Certification form.
2. Home School students with a minimum ACT score of 17, 820 on the old SAT, or 900 on the new SAT will be admitted to Angelo State University. This process mirrors the assured admission process for students graduating from a Texas public high school.
